**GENERAL ORDER
No. 03-23**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any attorney for an individual debtor and any pro se filer who does not submit Form B21 (Statement of Social Security Number) with a Chapter 7, 11, 12 or 13 Bankruptcy Petition shall submit to the Clerk a completed Form B21 within fifteen days of the date of filing of the Petition. The attorney or pro se debtor shall also serve a notice to all creditors, the trustee assigned to the case and to the United States Trustee setting forth each debtor's Social Security Number or stating that the debtor has no Social Security Number. Service of the notice shall be by first-class mail or certified mail. Proof of service of notice containing only the last four numbers of each debtor's Social Security Number shall be filed with the Clerk no less than 10 days prior to the § 341 meeting. (11 U.S.C. 341.)

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall be effective immediately.
