AMENDED ORDER GOVERNING TELEPHONIC PARTICIPATION IN HEARINGS

On the court's own motion, it is ordered that the following procedures will apply to participation by telephone in hearings in the above-captioned case:

1. *Only* attorneys representing parties in interest in the case may attend hearings by telephone. Parties themselves (whether represented or unrepresented), members of the public, and members of the press may not attend by telephone, although they are free to attend in person.

2(a). Subject to the exception in paragraph 2(b) of this order, attorneys may attend by telephone *only* if they have no office in the Northern District of Illinois, or if they have an office in the Northern District but that office is more than 100 miles from the courthouse. Otherwise, attorneys must attend in person.

2(b). Attorneys who represent parties in interest in the case and who practice in multi-office firms with offices both in the Northern District of Illinois and outside the district may attend by telephone only if *all* of the attorneys from the firm involved in the case are resident in an office outside of the district. If any attorney involved in the case is resident in an office in the Northern District of Illinois, *no* attorney from the firm may attend by telephone.

3. To "attend by telephone" means to listen *only*. Attorneys intending to address the court must attend hearings in person.

4. Attorneys who want to attend by telephone must arrange their own attendance by calling CourtCall at (866) 582-6878. *Do not contact chambers or the clerk's office.*

5. This order supersedes Standing Order No. 5 for purposes of this case.
