Complaint <b>Exception</b> – If the trustee or debtor-in-possession files the complaint, the fee must be paid only by the estate, to the extent there is an estate. <b>Exception</b> – This fee must not be charged if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The debtor is the plaintiff;</li> <li>• A child support creditor or representative files the complaint and submit the form required by §304(g) of the Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994;</li> <li>• Dischargeability complaints in chapter 11 and chapter 12 cases; or</li> <li>• Adversary proceeding is filed by the United States.</li> </ul>	\$293

AMENDMENT FEES	
Amendment to Debtor's Schedule of Creditors, List of Creditors or Mailing List <b>Exception</b> – The fee must not be charged if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To change the address of a creditor or an attorney for a creditor listed on the schedules;</li> <li>• To add the name and address of an attorney for a creditor listed on the schedules;</li> <li>• Debtor files a schedule of post-petition debts after converting from a chapter 13 to a chapter 7; or</li> <li>• Joint husband and wife case divides/splits.</li> </ul>	\$30
APPEAL FEES	
Notice of Appeal ( <i>includes filing fee of \$5</i> ) <b>Exception</b> – Parties filing a joint notice appeal should pay only one fee. <b>Exception</b> – If a trustee or debtor-in-possession is the appellant, the fee must be paid only by the estate, to the extent there is an estate. <b>Exemption</b> – When the U. S. Trustee is acting as trustee, no fee is due; however the clerk must collect the appellate docketing fee (\$5) and the cross appeal docketing fee (\$5). <b>Exception</b> – The fee must not be charged if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The debtor is the plaintiff; or</li> <li>• A Child Support Creditor or representative files the complaint and submits the form required by §304(g) of the Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1994.</li> </ul>	\$298
