REGARDING MATTERS INVOLVING THE
SPRINGER BROWN FIRM IN DU PAGE COUNTY
TO BE HEARD IN JOLIET, IL THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2011

Effective January 7, 2011

WHEREAS, Judge John H Squires has announced that he is retiring from the bench as of January 1, 2012 and will join the law firm of Springer, Brown, Covey, Gaertner and Davis, LLC (“Springer Brown firm”) as “of counsel” after he retires,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all matters in DuPage County in which the Springer Brown firm or any lawyer affiliated with the Springer Brown firm is a party in interest or represents a party in interest will be heard in Joliet, Illinois by Judge Bruce W. Black beginning Friday, January 14, 2011 and continuing until December 31, 2011.

All new matters in which the Springer Brown firm or any lawyer affiliated with the Springer Brown firm is a party in interest or represents a party in interest shall be noticed for the appropriate time slot on Judge Black’s Joliet call.

Matters involving Springer Brown that are already scheduled for hearing before Judge Squires in DuPage will be heard on the scheduled date in Joliet at the time slot at which Judge Black hears that type of matter (e.g., new chapter 7 and chapter 12 motions at 9:15 a.m., set or continued chapter 7 and chapter 12 motions at 9:30 a.m., new chapter 13 motions at 10:00 a.m., etc.). If the scheduled hearing date of any such matter is one on which Judge Black is not holding court in Joliet, the matter will be heard on the next date on which Judge Black holds court in Joliet.
