Background

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy [9036](#), a party may make a written request for delivery of notices via email, instead of U.S. mail.

- One email address per form Joint Debtors
- Actual penmanship signature. We will not accept /s/

Step by Step Instructions:

1. Select **Bankruptcy > Other A**
2. Enter the **Case Number**
 - Click Next
3. Verify you are docketing on the correct case
4. Select Debtor's Request for Electronic Notice and Consent to Service via Email from the pick list
 - Click Next
5. Select the **Debtor and / or Joint Debtor** from the pick list
6. Select the appropriate radio button:
